KOVAR Begins Thursday, April 14th

The Annual Statewide KOVAR (Knights of Virginia Assisting the Retarded) Drive will be held Thurs, Apr. 14th through Sunday, April 17th We distribute specially packaged Tootsie Rolls at various stores and ask for donations to support the Retarded. All our funds go to the State KOVAR Board that distributes the funds to organizations that help the Retarded and also make loans and grants for the establishment of group homes for the Retarded. This past year KOVAR dispensed about \$840,000 - \$600,000 in direct grants and \$240,000 in loans to group homes. Brother Knight Tim Tilson is a member of the State KOVAR Board and Tim Cooke is Chairman for our Council's drive this year. Please save some time to help that weekend. Our level of success is dependent on our turnout of help. Spouses and children are encouraged to participate also, so make it a family affair. Tim Cooke has now firmed up our collection sites and is ready to sign up volunteers for those locations, sign up early and get a good spot at a time that you can work. This is, as I mentioned, very labor intensive and we are going to need lots of help if we are going to meet our assigned goal of \$26,400 for this year. If you can't physically help, a donation would be appreciated, donations to KOVAR are tax deductible. The attached flier is a history of how the use of specially wrapped Tootsie Rolls is used in this program. It also gives the background of KOVAR in Virginia and our participation in the program.

Food Drive

Throughout the world millions of families are in need of support to meet their basic nutritional needs. Since 1990, the Members of Fr. Diamond Council have been helping to meet the needs of those less fortunate right here in our own back yard, Northern Virginia.

New Features at www.KofC.org

If you haven't visited the Knights of Columbus Web site in a while, I encourage you to do so the next time you're online. We've added many new features to www.kofc.org, but there are two that I wish to make you especially aware of.

The first is our member testimonial area, titled "Stages of Life." In this multi-media area, six "real-life" stories are told – stories of people at different stages of their lives. 


