

VOTE on May 19th—Absentee Ballot



Below is the city alert on absentee ballots. The City Voter Registration Office is being very liberal about this. Just select reason code 2A. They are not going to allow the normal voting but for those who show-up on 19th May they bring a voter machine to the car for the voting. Recommend the absentee ballot process.

"This is an important message from the City of Fairfax Alert System

If you are concerned about illness on Election Day May 19, apply today for your absentee ballot by mail. Select the illness reason and vote at home. If you are leaving the City for any reason on Election Day, request a ballot by mail. Use the reason that fits best. Complete an application online at www.vote.virginia.gov. OR print and complete an application and send it by mail to 10455 Armstrong St., Fairfax, VA 22030. OR email a picture or scan of your application to registrar@fairfaxva.gov. All absentee ballots must be requested no later than May 12. All absentee ballots
