



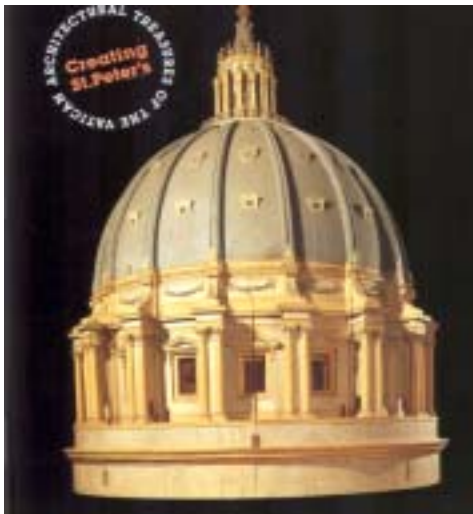

Architectural Treasures of the Vatican, Knights of Columbus Museum

Birthplace of the Knights of Columbus, Saint Mary's Church



The Vatican designed this show specifically for the Knights of Columbus museum. It contains more than 100 works of art and architecture, including antique models, paintings, engravings, plans, sculptures, mosaics and tools. All were used in the building of , or represent the design and construction of the world-famous, St. Peter's Basilica.

The centerpiece of the exhibit is the 16.5 foot high 2800 pound study model. The dome model is constructed of wood, now over 440 years old, and considered to be too frail to travel. So this showing at the Knights of Columbus Museum will be the last time it will be displayed in the United States.

From the Museum we will visit the birthplace of the Knights of Columbus, Saint Mary's Church.

After the visit of Saint Mary's we will take a guided bus tour of New Haven and return to Saint Mary's in time for 5:00PM Mass.

After Mass we will Dine with our Brother Knights at the Council Home of Council #5.
