Note: On Sunday, the start time for the first shift may be as early as 5am.

Admission Host Position Description: Take guest tickets, ensure the tickets are for the correct day, punch the ticket, give guest a wristband and event information, and direct guest to the bus. The admissions host may also have to inform guests that certain items cannot be taken on the bus ie. Coolers and chairs.

Benefits:

Off site admissions hosts are entitled to admission to the event on another designated day. They also can attend the event on the day of volunteering before or after their shift. All volunteer will be issued T-shirts

Training: Volunteer orientations will be held the last 3 weeks of April. Volunteers can choose 1 from a group of orienations available - dates to be announced. The Volunteer Office can do orientations for special groups at a site of their choice if there is a large group that would benefit. Position training would also be conducted the end of April/beginning of May.
