Father Diamond Council now has <u>SignUpGenius</u> for signing up to volunteer for KOVAR. If you would prefer to not use SignUpGenius then just call **Herb Zimmerman** at **703-623-6299** and he will help you sign up for an open slot.

Here's how to use SignUpGenius for KOVAR:

TO START - Click on the link KOVAR - April 20-23 and then follow these instructions:

- 1. Scroll down until you see Location you would like to work on left side
- 2. Scroll until you see the date you'd like to work (2nd column)
- 3. Pick an open time slot any with the blue box with "Sign Up" click in the little white box (you can select multiple slots if you like)
- 4. When done selecting the times and places you would like to work, click on the "Submit and Continue" box at the bottom
- 5. If you already have an account click in the radial button that says "I have an account" and sign into SignUpGenius, then go to step #7
- If you do not want to join SignUpGenius then be sure this radial button is black: "I do not have a SignUpGenius account"
- 7. Fill in your First Name and Last Name and email address (if you want a reminder sent otherwise leave it blank)
- 8. then click on: "Send me a confirmation email with an ICS file and a link that will allow me to edit this item later"
- 9. Please fill in your cell phone (so I can contact you on the day you are working)
- 10. Lastly, click on the "Sign Up Now" button. You will receive a Thank You message.
