



The next Exemplification for the Virginia District of the 4th Degree will be conducted on **Saturday, April 17th,** beginning at Noon. Due to the ongoing pandemic, this Exemplification will be held virtually. Fr. Malloy Assembly will host an in-person viewing of the Exemplification in the gym of St. Leo the Great Catholic School. The benefits of attending the viewing include: coffee & donuts will be made available prior to the ceremony; Candidates will be Knighted at the conclusion of the ceremony (those attending from home will be Knighted at a later time); and lunch will be provided after the ceremony. Cost is \$50 per Candidate (this is set by Supreme!); only requirement is that a Candidate MUST be a 3rd Degree Knight prior to the Exemplification.
